THE STUDENT DEBT CRISIS AND ITS IMPACT ON AFRICAN- AMERICAN SCHOLARS

AFRICAN-AMERICAN STUDENTS ARE IN A NATIONAL DEBT CRISIS.

The total - all races - student loan debt for more than 44 million U.S. student borrowers exceeds \$1.5 trillion.

On one hand, that's a testament to American students' desire to invest in themselves and their futures. On the other hand, that debt demonstrates a public policy failure to invest in today's students.

Nearly half of white public two-year college graduates (45%) and more than two-thirds (68%) of white public four-year college graduates leave school with debt. More than half (58%) of black public two-year graduates and (82%) of public four-year graduates complete their degrees with debt.

The crisis is impacting their ability to build wealth. More than 20% of black college graduates will default on their student loans, compared to about 4% of white graduates. This is directly linked to their ability to save, build wealth, give back to Hampton.
